

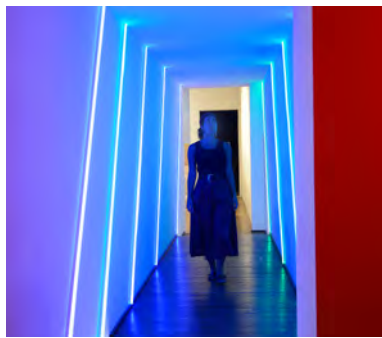


**WALTRAUT COOPER**

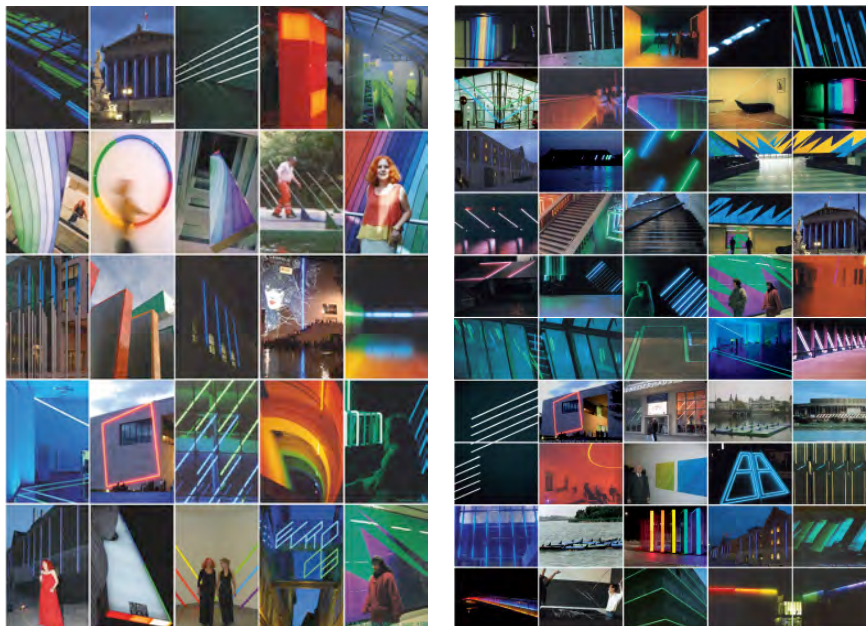
Studied art, mathematics and theoretical physics in Vienna, Paris (Sorbonne), Lisbon (A Gravura), Frankfurt (Städelschule).

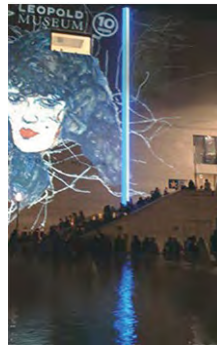

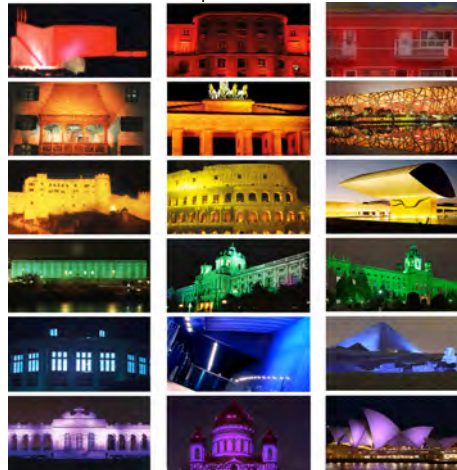
